- Promote feelings of trust and security in the program;
- Assist in completion of timely, neat, accurate documentation of infant daily sheets, toileting/diapering logs, assessments, screenings, attendance, inventory, temperature logs and other documentation that may be necessary for quality services;
- Simple daily house cleaning duties in classroom;
- Understand and apply mission statement;
- Greet participants and guests warmly and enthusiastically each day;
- Maintain safe, clean environment, teaching and modeling good hygiene skills;
- Assist in implementation and planning of program events;
- Attend trainings scheduled;
- Maintain a working knowledge of significant developments and trends in education; and Perform other duties as assigned.
